## **Our Learning This Week**







#### Year R

What a wonderful start to our final half term! We started our new topic of 'Glorious Gardens' by creating our very own Bug Hotels and then used this as a writing stimulus to write our own instructions. The writing that Year R are producing is just incredible and we are so very proud of them! All three classes had a special delivery at the beginning of the week – 5 little caterpillars in each class. The children are enjoying watching the caterpillars grow quickly and we cannot wait to see what happens with them. We have also had BugFest visit us where the children had the opportunity to get up close to various minibeasts including a millipede, cockroach, stick insects and many more!

Within maths, the children have been looking at the concept of sharing and grouping. They have been very practical with this and have shared out lots of different items between 2, 3 and even 4 different groups.

#### KS1

#### Year 1

We have had a fabulous first week back in Year 1! We started our final topic of 'Down Under' where the children had the opportunity to research Australia using non-fiction texts and iPads to explore their curiosity! We have been learning about Jonathan's animals from his website, asked questions and written captions in English all in time for his visit on Friday! The children were incredible when handling the animals. I think we can agree that Rafiki the Royal Python was definitely a favourite amongst all the classes- well done everyone! Next week we will be using our experiences from the visit to create our own waterfall information booklets! In Maths we have continued our learning in fractions looking at quarters and moving on to positions where we used the language of full, half, quarter and three quarter turns.

#### Year 2

We have been really looking forward to our trip to Minstead Study Centre today. We have looked at features of a recount in English this week, ready to write about the trip on Monday. In maths, we are starting our topic in statistics and have enjoyed going outside to count things in nature. We then produced tally charts to log our data. In geography, we have been recapping what we know about continents and oceans. We then introduced our new topic, habitats around the world. We have discussed what we already know about rainforests and the Arctic. We have also discussed what we would like to find out about the two. Lastly, please could you keep practicing your reading at home and discuss what you have read from the book to really help and develop understanding. We look forward to telling you all about our exciting trip next time.
