Our Learning This Week

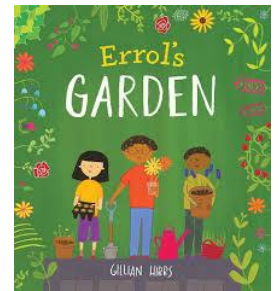


Year R

In Maths, the children have been learning all about mapping. They have been busy building their own gardens using positional language, using instructions to guide their partners around the school and creating their very own maps to read. The children have been very excited to meet their new Year 1 teachers this week and visit their new classrooms. This week in Year 1 the have planned our own story based on 'The Koala who Could'. They thought about their own Australian animal and thought about why they do not want to leave their habitat. In maths, we have learnt about money by recognising the coins we use and understanding their value. We then went on to learn about the value of notes. They had a great time in science designing their own habitat for an animal of their choice.

Year 2

This week the children have researched and written all about rainforests in their English lessons. They have continued their learning about position and movement through practical and written work in Mathematics. In Geography, we explored how animals adapt to survive in different habitats and have drawn and written about an imaginary creature that is adapted to life in either a Rainforest or the Arctic. 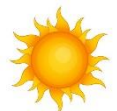
